That same evening we went to a charismatic Catholic house of prayer in Augsburg, Germany, where Eddie was invited to speak. This was the same week they went 24/7 with prayer and worship. It was exciting to see young people gathered to give themselves to prayer. The Lord is really raising up prayer in the nations and especially with the youth and young adults. This whole trip was such a blessing. Connecting with family was so good and refreshing. We miss Eddie's mother and are very thankful for our time together!
