

## Our Program

Early childhood is a critical time in the development of a child's perceptions of self, others, the world, and God. Our program is designed to focus on building and nurturing these developmental areas:

- The spiritual, social, emotional, intellectual, cognitive, language, and physical development of every child.
- Integrates play as the vital way children learn.
- Provides experiences in language and creative arts, music, dramatic play, large and small motor activity, math and science.
- Incorporates and exemplifies Christian values.

## Sessions Offered

**Three Year Old Class** This program is designed to introduce children to social interactions in a developmental setting.

Thursday & Friday 9:00 am—11:30 am

**Four Year Old Class** This class is designed as an in-between class for 3's with summer and fall birthdays who may wait a year for kindergarten.

Thursday & Friday 12:30 pm—3:00 pm

**Pre-K Classes** This program is designed to expand upon the developmental educational experiences for 4's & 5's and prepare them for Kindergarten.

Morning Session: M/T/W 9:00 am—11:30 am

Afternoon Session: M/T/W, 12:30 pm—3:00 pm

Children need to be potty-trained before entering preschool.

## The Environment

We provide a learning environment designed to permit discovery and application which are age appropriate. Our environment looks like the following:

- Promotes creative thinking and problem solving
- Capitalizes on children's natural curiosity and instinct for learning
- Has a well-equipped classroom that incorporates learning centers and is rich in print
- Has a spacious outside play area and a gym with equipment that encourages play and physical development
- Provides monthly field trips
- Has a Christmas Program and a Graduation Program
- Meets stringent health and safety standards
