

Financial Support of Student-led Conferences on Pentecostalism

When deemed appropriate, SPS may contribute funding to student organizations at colleges, universities, and seminaries in order to support the hosting of conferences related to Pentecostal Studies. At least one member of the requesting organization must be a member of SPS. SPS may at the discretion of the Executive Director in consultation with the Executive Committee contribute up to \$1,000 per calendar year with a maximum of \$500 per event (with these limitations to be reviewed periodically).

Any student organization interested in receiving financial assistance for such an endeavor may apply via email to the Executive Director of SPS. Inclusion of the following information is required: 1) Name of organization, 2) Date of founding, 3) Names and contact information of student and faculty leadership, 4) Size of membership, 5) Name, theme and purpose of conference, 6) Date and location of conference, 7) Confirmed and/or invited speakers, 8) Amount of funding provided by your institution, 9) Anticipated budget for the conference, and 10) Names of student members who are members of the Society for Pentecostal Studies.

Student organizations accepting funding must agree to distribute material regarding the Society for Pentecostal Studies to all participants in the conference and submit a brief written report of the conference within three months of its conclusion.
