I am a creative leader who is focused on enabling the success of those I lead. I love to build teams and ministries that will long outlive my involvement. I do not believe that I am indispensable. Rather, I think my role is to build up others to the point that they can lead. I have long felt that effective leaders build effective teams, and I have tried to exemplify that principle.
