Facility Use Rules and Guidelines

Damage Clause

- The couple must have the prior approval of the Business Administrator and Elder Board before using the facility.
- No alcoholic beverages are allowed on the church property, or in the facility, by any members or guest of the requesting party.
- No food or drink allowed in the Sanctuary.
- No dances are allowed in the church facility.
- No tobacco products are allowed on the church property, or in the facility, by any members or guest of the requesting party.
- All times agreed upon by requesting party for arrival and departure from the building will be honored.
- The Elder Board or their designee, can limit the number of hours the facility is available for any given event or wedding.
- Participants of an event will refrain from entering parts of the building not specified for use.
- Equipment, furniture, and other items or property of the church will not be moved or displaced without prior approval.
- Non-traditional decorative items or supplies will have to have the approval of the custodian or stewardship team prior to their use.
- All non-traditional decorative items shall be removed from the church after the wedding or event.
- All candle arrangements will have a protective covering placed under them to protect furniture and the carpet.
- No rice, birdseed, real flower petals, etc., in the building or around the building premises.
