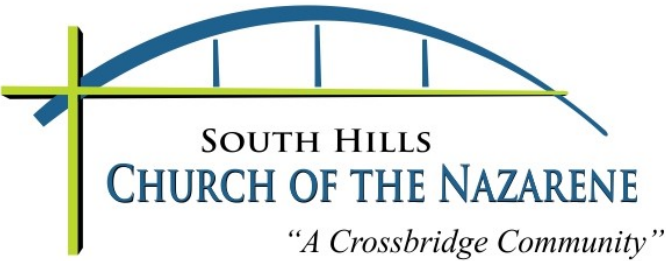

The next Prime time outing will be...

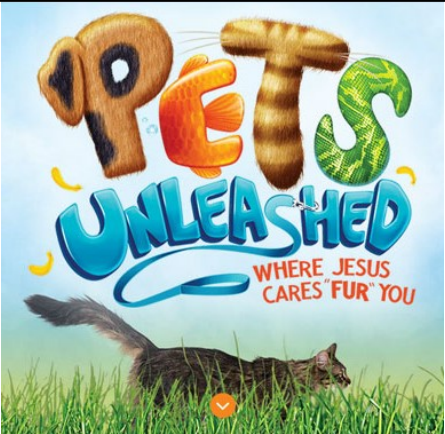
July 13—Lunch out followed by a visit to Fort Necessity and other historical sites of the French and Indian War.
