# SOUL MINISTRIES

We are a 501(c)3 non-profit corporation made up of churches and civic groups who have come together to provide services and outreach to people within our area and who are in need. We began in 1988 and are located in the brown building adjacent to Springdale Nazarene Church.

We operate two distinct mercy ministries, both of which are located on this property:

## FOOD PANTRY

Our food pantry is stocked with food, household and cleaning items, toiletries, paper goods and even clothing items available to those who qualify.

## CARING CENTER

The Caring Center is a faith-based opportunity for clients to engage in a Christian fellowship relationship which can provide resourcing in many areas to enable a true hand up through the power of Jesus Christ.

# FOOD PANTRY

We serve our neighbors in Greenhills (45218), Springdale (45246), Forest Park (45240) -[except Seven Hills], and those referred by our sponsor church congregations.

We are a “**choice food pantry**” where clients may shop one (1) time per month. It is your choice how you spend your points. Points are determined by family size and qualification for current USDA rules. A volunteer is always present while shopping to assist you and keep track of your points.

### New Clients

New clients must show two (2) current bills dated within the last month as proof of residency, such as a Duke, water, phone bill or rent receipt. You also need a Social Security card or birth certificate for each family member.

### Continuing Clients

Continuing clients must provide one (1) bill, no more than one month old. And, for school aged children you must produce proof from the school (report card, progress report or letter) on your 2nd visit that the children live at your address. We cannot count them for food until you do.

### All Clients

All clients must have a picture I.D. available at each visit.

# CARING CENTER

It is the goal of the Caring Center to work with our clients to change their lives by becoming involved in a Christian fellowship and working toward goals that will change their overall living situation for the better. ***We are committed to becoming a ministry that truly offers a loving hand up to our clients through the power of Jesus Christ.***

There are three (3) main requirements to be a part of the Caring Center:

1. We ask that our Caring Center clients attend a church regularly. We are willing to help you find a church home if you currently do not have one. Our goal is to walk with you on a journey of faith and hope, as we work with you to help you better your situation.
2. Everyone must be receiving, have applied for or be willing to apply for, food stamps.
3. You must apply for H.E.A.P. (Home Energy Assistance Program) - unless your heat is provided by your landlord.

### All Clients

All clients must be selected by application only and must be willing to conform to our stated standards.
