## What to Pack:

### **Bedding**

- pillow

### **Toiletries**

- shower caddy or bucket to tote toiletries
- soap
- shampoo
- toothbrush / toothpaste
- comb / brush
- deodorant
- bath towels / washcloths

### **Miscellaneous**

- Bible** / journal
- writing materials
- sunscreen
- insect repellent
