Dear Praying Friends,

As we approach the one year anniversary of Star Baptist Church (July 7, 2013) and reflect on the past year, we can echo the sentiment of the Psalmist:

"The LORD hath done great things for us; whereof we are glad." Psalm 126:3

As is always the case, when God is blessing, our "adversary the devil" (1 Peter 5:8) ratchets up his attempts to hinder or thwart God's work. Since our Charter Signing Service and last prayer letter in March, we have had to exercise Biblical church discipline on a young couple who refused to obey the Lord's directive in Matthew 19:6 "What therefore God hath joined together, let not man put asunder." We have also been denied a tax exemption on our property for the 2014 tax year by the Ada County Board of Commissioners due to a clause in the tax code which stipulates that the property must be "occupied" on January 1, 2014 to qualify for the exemption. We are appealing the decision, so please make this a special matter of prayer. With that said, we are confident that God's good hand of blessing will continue upon His work here in Star and that He will give us wisdom and victory as we "fight the good fight of faith" (1 Timothy 6:12).

Here are a couple of blessings Star Baptist Church has experienced over the past few months:

- ☆ In April I was able to attend the 24th Annual Northwest Bible Conference at Summerville Baptist Church (Pastor Franklin Humber) in Summerville, OR. This is always a great time of spiritual challenge and fellowship. From the churches represented at the conference, we received \$450.00 toward the expense of signage for the facade of our building. We have purchased the lettering and will be installing it soon--Lord willing.
- ☆ In June we enjoyed a visit from Pastor Scott Blair
  (Willow Grove Independent Baptist Church, Waynesburg,
  PA) and his lovely family. Pastor Blair preached in the
  AM service and his family joined us for lunch before
  starting their journey home to PA. It was a blessing to
