2. **Not all donations are created equal.** Only credit card donations will activate the match code. (Check payments won't be eligible for matching.). During check-out, enter the word **BLOOM** where it says "Match or gift code", and your donation will be matched dollar for dollar.

Baptism and Confirmation are referred to together as "rites of initiation." Baptism brings us into the life of the Church and Confirmation strengthens us in our commitment to the faith. Both children and adults are invited to be baptized! It is a sign of Christ's love for us, at any age!! Historically, the major time for baptisms in the life of the Christian Church is at the Easter Vigil. We will be holding an Easter Vigil at the church on Easter Sunday morning, April 8th, at the early service, which will be moved to 6:45 a.m., so that it may include the traditional Service of Light. IF that is a bit **early** for you, you and/or your children may be baptized at the second service on Easter Sunday, which will be at the usual time, 9:30 a.m. There will be a celebration brunch between service and an Easter egg hunt after the second service. Adults and youth from age 16 and above are encouraged to be *confirmed* (if not baptized, they are baptized at the same time). At a confirmation service, other individuals may also be **received into the Church** (if confirmed in many other traditions), and it is quite moving and **appropriate for any and all to renew their Baptismal vows**. We have a unique opportunity this year to have **confirmations, receptions, and renewal of vows at the campfire site at Family Camp (we can even do Baptisms at the Beach if so desired)**. Again, please contact Mother Giovan to be a part of this important rite in our lives as Christians. (Confirmation classes begin after Easter.)
