October 4 Francis of Assisi (1181-1226), friar and priest and founder of the Franciscan Order. Born to a wealthy family, he renounced his inheritance to become a friar. His simple life style, renunciation of wealth, generosity, love of nature and deep devotion, have made him popular in the 21st century. **October 6 William Tyndale** (1494-1536) biblical scholar. His translation of the scriptures from the Greek and Hebrew into then contemporary English, became the basis for the Authorised Version.
