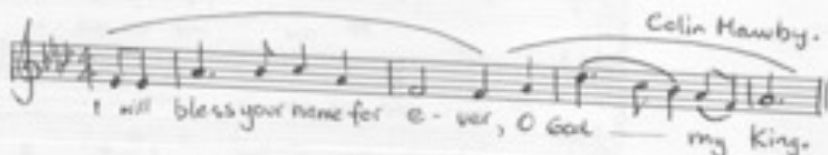

He will be looking at how Merton was one of the people of the 20th century who embodied grace and redemption in a world where the news was so often bleak and without hope. Rob says of what he will share with us: "Off the top of my head I'd be inclined to talk about Merton's disillusion with monastic life - and religious life generally - in later life: "How do you live out a full-blooded spirituality in such a bloodless church?" I will speak about the failings of the institution and the unknown future, but pointing to where Merton offers some hard won hope in the end about living in a heartless world."

During late September / early October, the Curate will be facilitating a bible study from the excellent UK York Courses.

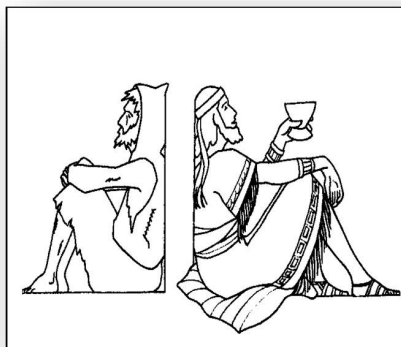
The Topic will be
