This will be a valuable opportunity to learn from others as we hear how they live their faith today.

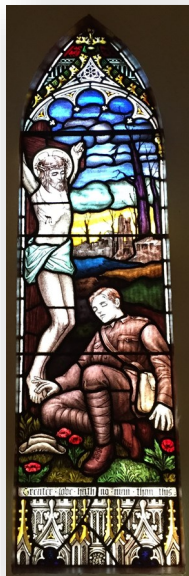
#### **BOOK CLUB**
