This morning at 8am we welcome John Rogerson (Churches of Christ) and Alex Kats (Jewish)

who are presenters in the Grassroots Dialogue project of The Council of Christians and Jews. Since its establishment 30 years ago the Victorian Council of Christians and Jews has been at the forefront of inter-faith dialogue in Melbourne. The Grass Roots Dialogue Project is the latest program initiated by the CCJ to promote engagement between Christians and Jews. The Project offers a "taster" of what dialogue is about to members of Christian and Jewish communities on their home turf. On 3 May the 10am congregation will take part with two other presenters.

Alex Kats is a Project Manager who has worked in all three tiers of Australia's governments. He is Jewish and has been a volunteer in no less than 20 Jewish organisations over the last two or more decades. He also is a regular synagogue goer and is passionate about Jewish education and about debunking myths about Judaism that non-Jews may have, which is partly why he is involved in this project.

John Rogerson has been Chief Executive of the Australian Drug Foundation (ADF) since 2008 and has 20 years'
