Roses for our front Garden

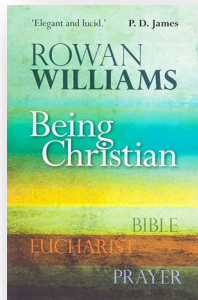


We are still seeking donations for roses as the cost of the standard roses supplied, instead of bare rooted roses, worked out at \$50.00 each
