Palm Sunday

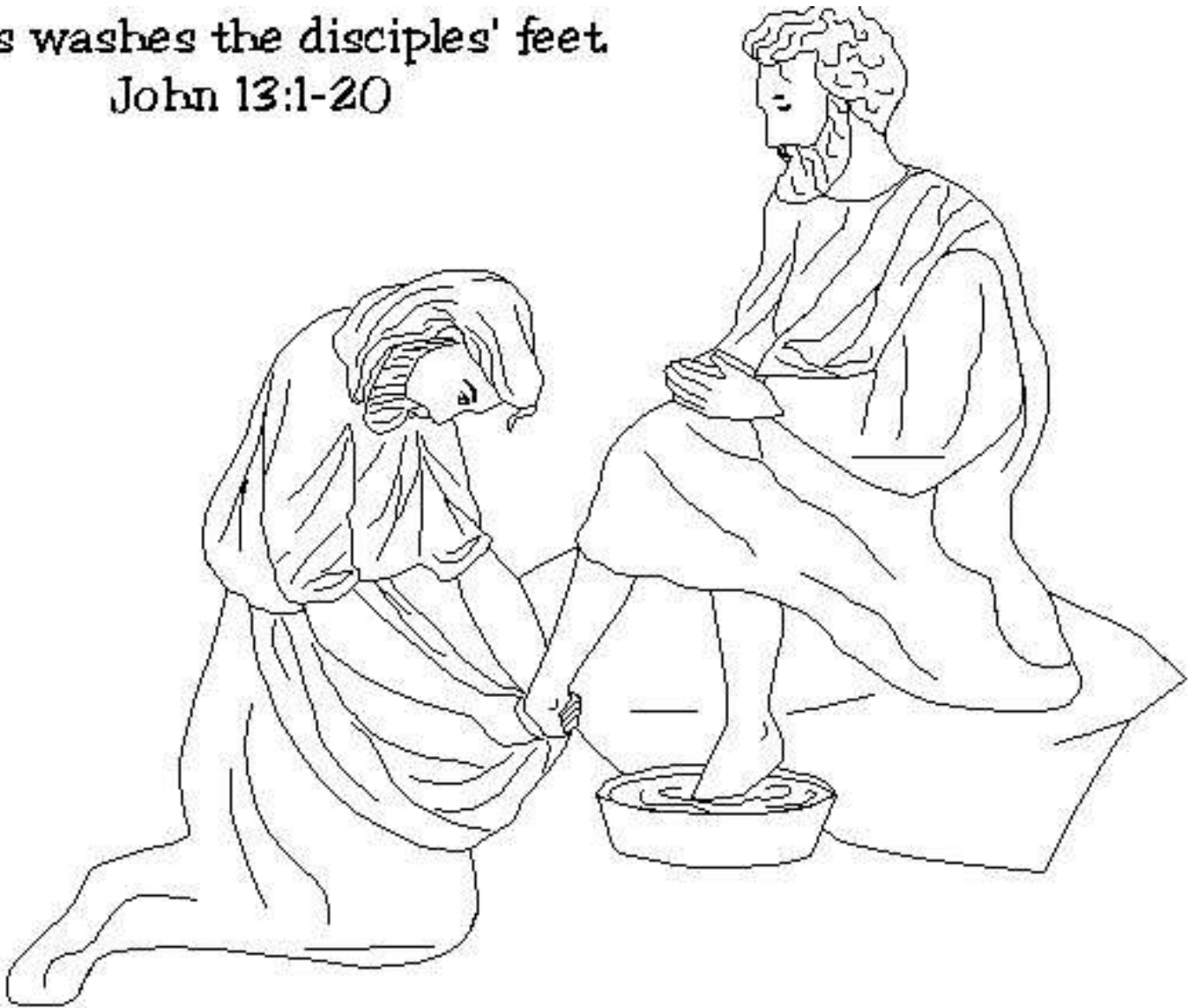


Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem

Jesus rode into Jerusalem on a donkey. The people praised God and waved palm branches to show that they believed that he was their King.

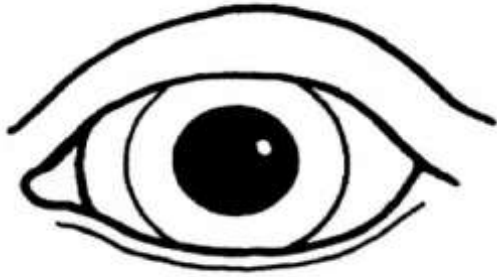
Maundy Thursday

This is a very sad day. It is when Jesus died on the cross for us.

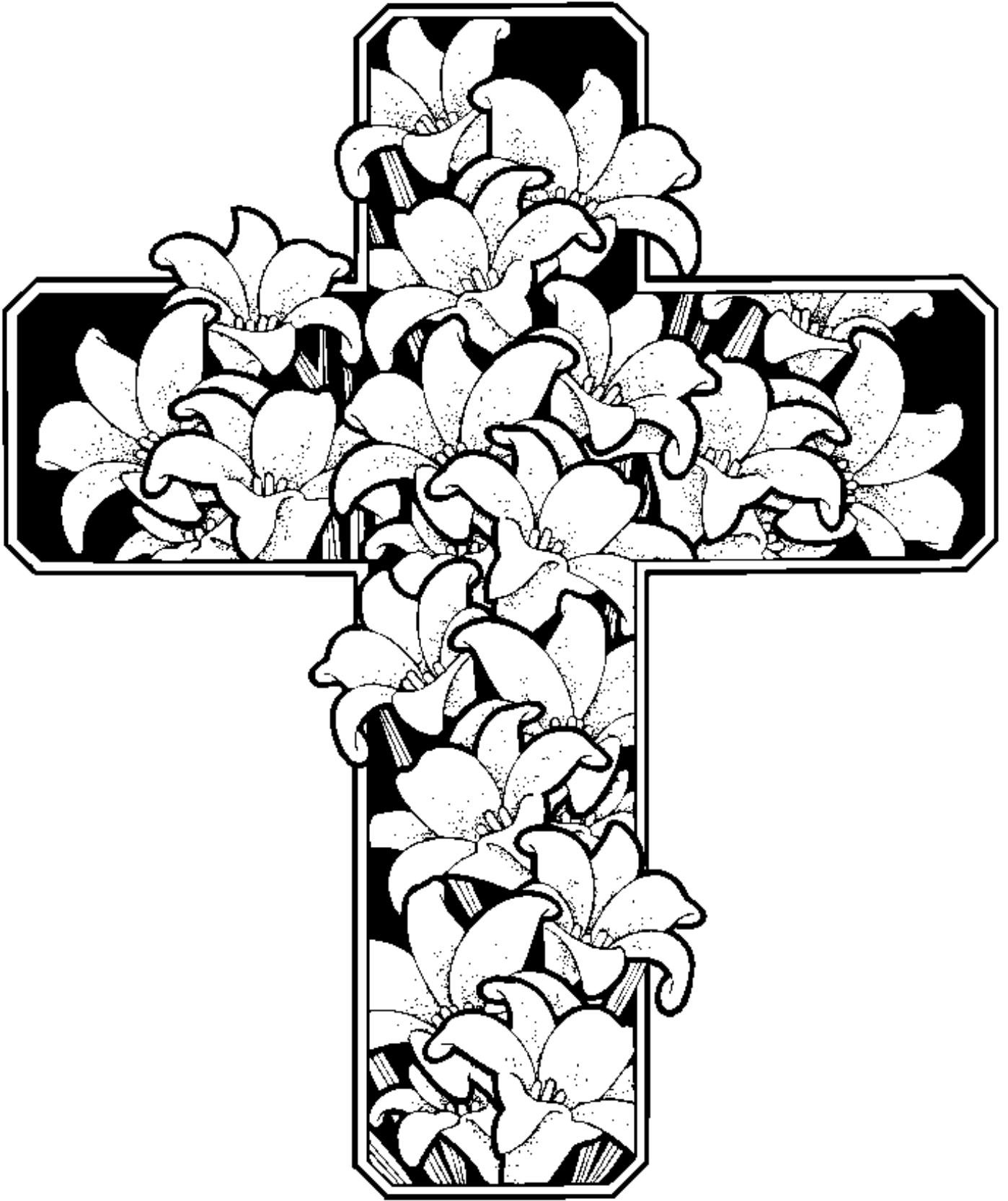
Easter Sunday
