Carillonneur Jonathan Lehrer to play at St. John's

You are invited to a Carillon Recital presented by Jonathan Lehrer at St. John's on Saturday, July 31 at 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon.

Jon Lehrer began his carillon studies in 2000 at Yale University. Since graduating with a degree in Mathematics, he has been a frequent performer on the carillons of Frederick, Maryland and Arlington Cemetery, Virginia, and has played five concert tours spanning the US, Canada, Belgium, and the Netherlands. Jon is a laureate of the prestigious Queen Fabiola International Carillon Competition, and one of only two carillonners to ever represent America in the finals of the competition. He is a recipient of the SABAM prize for best interpretation of Flemish carillon music and the second place winner of the International Carillon Competition of the Dutch Carillon Guild. Jon holds a diploma from the



Belgian Royal Carillon School 'Jef Denyn' where he studied with Eddy Marien, Geert D'Hollander, and Koen Cosaert, and is a carillonner member of the Guild of Carillonners of North America. From 2008-2009, Jon was invited to perform the Cast

in Bronze theatrical carillon show on the Mobile Millenium Carillon across the country. Currently, Jon travels and performs classical and pops carillon concerts around the world.
