Are you aware that there is a program in the area that can help you or a loved one who is unable to shop for themselves or prepare a nutritious meal? It is called “Meals on Wheels.”

Meals on Wheels delivers warm meals and soup around the noon hour throughout the valley, including Brookfield and Masury, Ohio. There is a fee of \$4.00 a day for the main meal and soup. For an extra dollar, a lunch bag is added that contains a sandwich, milk, juice, salad, and dessert. If you have a certain diet

restriction, Meals on Wheels can accommodate. You can receive the meal as many weekdays as you would like. If in need, call 724-342-2042 Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.
