Enrollment Incentive Program Guidelines for 2017-2018

School growth often comes through word of mouth via enthusiastic and satisfied families. In order to capitalize on these testimonials, St. John's Lutheran Church has established the following program as an incentive for our school families to actively recruit new families into our school setting, both member and community member. Any currently enrolled family attending St. John's Lutheran School is eligible to participate. The definition of "new" and "sponsor" families shall be as follows:

New Families - *Shall be those families who are not currently enrolled with St. John's Lutheran School or Early Childhood Center in the 2016-17 School Year and will have children eligible for the K5-8 program for the 2017-18 school year.*

Sponsor Families – *Shall be those families who are currently (2016-17) enrolled with St. John's Lutheran School or Early Childhood Center who have children that will be eligible for the K5-8 program in the 2017-18 school year.*

Here are the program guidelines:

1. The "new" family must complete the entire school year (2017-18) with no delinquent tuition payments.
2. The "new" family will designate the corresponding sponsor family to receive the tuition voucher at the time of enrollment. Only 1 family may be designated.
3. The sponsoring family's tuition voucher of \$500.00 will be applied to their June 2018 payment.
4. Should the new family enroll in the school during the course of the school year other than the August enrollment time frame; the sponsor's voucher will be pro-rated against the actual months attended, i.e. if a new family enrolls in October, the sponsor family's credit would be 80% of the \$500.00 voucher.
