

The York County CROP (Communities Responding to Overcome Poverty) **Hunger Walk** is a three mile walk on Sunday, November 6 at 3 p.m. (Registration opens at 2 p.m.) It begins on the lawn of Dinkins on the Winthrop Campus. Walkers collect contributions by asking friends, family, and others to sponsor their efforts. What's the point of walking? Hungry people in developing countries walk on average as many as six miles a day to get food, water and fuel, or to take their goods to market. We walk in Rock Hill to be in solidarity with their struggle for existence. We walk to help end hunger – one step at a time. 25% of the money raised on the walk stays right here in our community and the other 75% goes all over the world and is distributed by Church World Service.
