St. John's Preschool is available for children who are three months to four years of age. Children are placed into classrooms based on age as of September 1st. Each classroom has two teachers. All teachers and staff have had a background check, and are CPR and First Aid certified. Our 4K Lead teachers have a degree in either Early Childhood or Elementary Education.

It is the mission of St. John's Preschool to provide a safe nurturing Christian environment that encourages the intellectual, physical, social, emotional and spiritual development of each child through play and active learning.

The children are provided with opportunities to learn through hands on experiences in art, stories, puppets, songs, music, cooking, gym time, outside play, and using manipulatives. Newsletters and calendars are sent home weekly to inform parents of the up-coming classroom activities, Bible themes and important dates along with sending home creations that the children have made in the classroom. Children will go to chapel twice a month for a short devotional. In addition, children receive music, Spanish and yoga lessons.

## Cost per child

Registration/Supply/Snack fee: Annual/non-refundable and can be paid in two installments. ½ must accompany application form and the other half must be paid by March 30<sup>th</sup>.

### **Early Morning Drop Off**
