FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Unless my memory is even worse than it sometimes is, the ancient poet **Horace** (65 BC -8 BC) was the most difficult author to translate of all the Latin ones we encountered in the nine years we were asked to study that taxing but beautiful and useful language. The reason for this was his masterful ability to condense thoughts into no more words than he found it necessary to use.

Among the various forms of poetry Horace wrote were his *Odes*, or lyrical verses. In a recent review of Richard Jenkyns's book *Classical Literature*, Christopher Krebs noted that

In Horace's ode on wintry Mount Soracte, ... with atmospheric language gently set to the rhythm of an Alcaic strophe, the poet takes us from the bristling cold outside to the inside of a hut, where smoldering logs crackle with warmth and a cup of wine is raised to toast life. "Don't ask what tomorrow will bring," he advises; rather, "count every day that is given to you a gift."

That's an excellent thought to keep in mind as we approach Thanksgiving Day.

I hope all the nervousness we have lately had to endure because of the viral epidemic won't impair your enjoyment of the holiday, which so many look forward to eagerly.

Our one Mass that day, at 8:30 am, will be a fine way to begin thanking God for all the good things in our lives, which are many, no matter how we are faring.

A number of the Psalms voice eloquent thoughts of gratitude, including Ps 63, which thanks God in deeply affecting, straightforward words:

Your constant love is better than life
itself, and so I will praise you.

I will give you thanks as long as I
live; I will raise my hands to you
in prayer.

My soul will feast and be satisfied,
and I will sing glad songs of
praise to you.

As I lie in bed, I remember you; all
night long I think of you, because
you have always been my help.

In the shadow of your wings I sing
for joy.

I cling to you, and your hand keeps
me safe.

Perhaps you can include these words in your prayers for Thanksgiving Day.

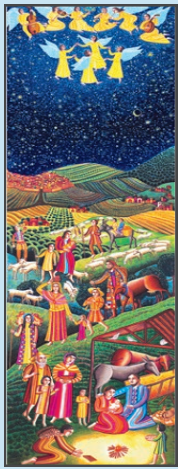

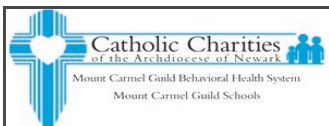

PUBLIC MASS GUIDELINES

- **ARRIVE EARLY** (20 minutes before Mass) and safely line up outside. Doors will open 15 minutes before Mass. **WEAR A FACE MASK** at all times while on the parish campus (both indoors and outside) and maintain **SAFE SOCIAL DISTANCING (6 feet)**.
- **ENTER via Elm St. or Harrison St. doors ONLY.** (*Grand St. entrance is handicapped-access only*).
- **HAND SANITIZER** is available and must be used upon entering and exiting.
- You will be seated in **alternating pews**.
- **No physical contact** during the *Sign of Peace*.
- **COMMUNION** will be distributed to **one entire side of the church and then the other** starting from a **single, socially distanced line** up the center aisle.
- When processing forward to receive, **keep mask on** and follow the blue floor markings.
- **PAUSE AT THE SOLID BLUE LINE**, and **WAIT** until a priest/minister is available.
- Holy Communion is permitted in the **HAND ONLY**.
- Once the consecrated host is placed in your hand, **step to the side, remove your mask briefly** to consume, then **immediately reposition your mask** and return to your seat.
- **AFTER FINAL BLESSING remain in your pew** until a minister instructs you to move; exit the pew when prompted and proceed directly outside onto the campus.
- **No private prayer or gathering** after Sunday Mass is permitted to allow for church cleaning.
- **Please do not congregate** outside.
