Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults
In today's Gospels, Jesus says to the Apostles "Peace be with you, as the Father has sent me, so I send you." He breathed on them and said "Receive the Holy Spirit". With these words, Jesus is also instructing

us to go forth as He did and to love and serve His people. Thomas was not with the apostles and did not believe that Jesus had appeared. When later Jesus appeared again, Thomas was with them, but still doubting, he needed to check Jesus' wounds to believe. And Jesus said "Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed." Are we like Thomas? Or do we truly believe? How has Easter and the Resurrection changed your life? For our newest recipients (Neophytes) of the Sacraments of Initiation, this Easter season is a time of reflection; 1) on the Sacraments they have received and 2) time to discern how they are being called to use their special talents and gifts in God's community which will bring them closer to Jesus.
