

## The Clergy of St. Mark's



Four former rectors of St. Mark's who had become bishops gathered in the parish house at the time of the consecration in 1943 of Everett H. Jones, far right, as Bishop of the Diocese of West Texas. ### Rectors

1858–61: Lucius H. Jones; came to St. Mark's from St. Andrew's, Seguin, TX; left to be Chaplain in the Fourth Regiment, Texas Mounted Volunteers, Confederate Army.

1862–65: William T. Dickinson Dalzell; from Christ Church, Houston; to St. Mark's, Shreveport, LA.

1865: Joseph J. Nicholson; from Chaplain, Confederate Army post at Talladega, AL; died as rector.

1866–68: Edwin A. Wagner; from Christ Church, Houston; to missionary work in Marshall, TX.

1868–1906: Walter R. Richardson; from St. Stephen's, Huntsville, TX; retired as rector.

1906–10: J. Lindsay Patton; from St. John's, Jacksonville, FL; to Church of the Good Shepherd, Jacksonville, FL.

1910–16: Philip Cook; from Chapel of the Incarnation, New York, NY; to St. Michael and All Angels, Baltimore, MD; Bishop of Delaware 1920–38; president of National Council of the Episcopal Church 1934–37.

1917–20: W. Bertrand Stevens; from St. Ann's, New York, NY; to Bishop Coadjutor/Bishop of Los Angeles 1920–47.

1921–25: S. Arthur Huston; from Christ Church, Baltimore, MD; to Bishop of Olympia, WA 1925–47.

1926–31: Rolfe P. Crum; from Trinity Church, Tulsa, OK; to St. Andrew's, Philadelphia, PA.

1931–38: Arthur R. McKinstry; from St. Paul's, Albany, NY; to Christ Church, Nashville, TN; Bishop of Delaware 1939–54.

1938–43: Everett H. Jones; from National Cathedral, Washington, DC; to Bishop of West Texas 1943–68.

1943–45: Thomas H. Wright; from Grace Cathedral, San Francisco, CA; to Bishop of East Carolina 1945–73.

1946–48: J. Wilson Hunter; from St. Andrew's, Louisville, KY; to Bishop of Wyoming 1949–69.

1948–68: Harold C. Gosnell; from Holy Trinity, Lincoln, NE; to Bishop Coadjutor/Bishop of West Texas 1969–77.

1968–79: Stanley F. Hauser; from St. Mark's, Houston; to Suffragen Bishop of West Texas 1979–87.

1980–91: Sudduth R. Cummings; from Church of the Incarnation, Dallas; to St. Timothy's, Baltimore, MD.

1992–93: James E. Folts; from Church of the Advent, Brownsville, TX; to Bishop Coadjutor/Bishop of West Texas 1994–06.

1994–Present: Michael D. Chalk; from St. James the Apostle, Conroe, TX.
