An update on Pr. Kate! Pr. Kate slipped on a steep path at her cabin and broke her leg and ankle in four places. She had surgery with a rod placed in the tibia, a plate alongside the fibula, and ankle, and rods, plates and screws throughout. Kate will be confined to a wheelchair for two months. She is recovering at her parent's home, which is handicapped accessible. When Pr. Kate is able to return to St. Mark's in the fall she will be using a walker for 2-4 months more. Pr. Kate is in good spirits, thankful for God's sustaining care, an outstanding orthopedic surgeon, a nice place to recover, good health insurance, excellent drugs, family support, and the prayers of sisters & brothers in faith. We would like to help Kate by giving her the time and energy to heal. We are collecting cards at the church and sending them to her. Just mail or deliver your card to the church office and we will take care of the details!

St. Mark's Eat, Pray, Laugh Group will be completing school kits for Lutheran World Relief.
