Living the Gospel...

Who Are We?

This is by far one of my favorite questions of the Scriptures, Jesus asking who do people think he is and who do the disciples say he is... I often wonder how would we answer the question?, and quite readily there are all kinds of answers that come to mind, where we are from, our ethnicity, our gender, our religion, our vocation or careers, but who we are is best reflected by Paul in our second reading from Galatians:

Brothers and sisters:

Through faith you are all children of God in Christ Jesus.

For all of you who were baptized into Christ

have clothed yourselves with Christ.

There is neither Jew nor Greek,

there is neither slave nor free person,

there is not male and female;

for you are all one in Christ Jesus.

And if you belong to Christ,

then you are Abraham's descendant,

heirs according to the promise.

We are God's children through our faith, we put on Christ through our baptism and we are one in Christ Jesus and belong, therefore to Christ. Our identity is not so much about what we have achieved or where or to whom we were born but rather about our relationship to God and each other. In other words, saying all these things about ourselves, that God loves us, we are His children and that in our baptism we become more than mere social beings inhabiting the same plant but rather we become responsible for each and each other's growth in Christ. Again Paul reminds us that we are all brothers and sisters and that we are ALL children of God.

Easy to say or write I know, but to live the great commandment is the greatest challenge of the Gospel, "love others as I have loved you."

Hermanos y hermanas:

Por la fe todos somos hijos de Dios en Cristo Jesús.

Para todos los que habéis sido bautizados en Cristo

se han revestido de Cristo.

No hay ni Judío ni griego;

no hay siervo ni libre,

no hay varón y hembra;

porque todos vosotros sois uno en Cristo Jesús.

Y si ustedes pertenecen a Cristo,

entonces usted es descendiente de Abraham,

herederos según la promesa.

Somos hijos de Dios a través de nuestra fe, nos revestimos de Cristo por nuestro bautismo y somos uno en Cristo Jesús y por lo tanto pertenecemos a Cristo. Nuestra identidad no es tanto lo que hemos logrado o dónde hemos nacido, sino más bien acerca de nuestra relación con Dios y entre nuestro prójimo. En otras palabras, decimos estas cosas sobre nosotros mismos, que Dios nos ama, que somos sus hijos y que en nuestro bautismo nos convertimos en más que simples seres sociales que habitan en la misma planta y nos hacemos responsables de cada uno y del otro el crecimiento en Cristo. Una vez más Pablo nos recuerda que todos somos hermanos y hermanas y que todos somos hijos de Dios.

Fácil de decir o escribir, lo sé, pero vivir el gran mandamiento es el reto más grande del Evangelio, "amar a otros como Yo os he amado."

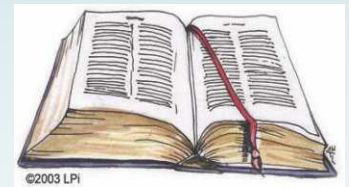
Haitian Refugees

Parish Evangelization

"There are no strangers here... only friends we haven't met."

Yesterday, as I was leaving work at the end of the day, I spotted a very sad sight. There, in front of me, lying on the hot asphalt in the alley was a bouquet of flowers. They looked more purchased than hand-picked, for they were neatly bound and wrapped in cellophane. There were daisies of different colors, some species that I could not identify, and some greens which, in the heat, had begun to wither and pale. The abandoned flowers were a gift, I presumed, and I found myself wondering about the incident or circumstances which led to them lying there. Flowers are a unique kind of gift. They celebrate significant occasions – both happy and sad. They have the flexibility to adorn a prom dress or to soften a funeral chapel. Flowers, it seems, are seldom purchased for one's self; part of their identity seems to be "gift". They have a reputation for mending marital troubles, for healing hospitalized friends, for beautifying birthday buffets. Why, then, was this gift bouquet lying on the ground in the hot sun? What potential did it have?

Perhaps an anxious giver running down the alley chased someone in a limo, and with loving abandon reached out the bouquet to give it to the receiver who expected something else and pushed the gift away until it dropped, with the limo running over the stems. Or, maybe, the giver carried the bouquet all nervous and uncertain, wondering "Will my flowers be good enough?" as he set them in front of an apartment door with a card, only to anxiously return later to discover that they were rejected and thrown out the window into the dumpster, but instead of hitting the dumpster, landed in the alley. Or, perhaps the giver was carrying several gifts to bring to a friend who was very ill, including a box of candy, a stuffed animal, a crossword book, and a bunch of balloons. Overloaded with gifts when it began to rain, he rushed to get inside and dropped the flowers.

Today's readings reminded me of those orphaned flowers I discovered. *Each of the readings speaks of gifts more beautiful and lasting than flowers.* Jesus, like the flowers, was rejected by many. Sometimes God sets gifts in our lives unexpectedly, and we reject them, and they wind up lying in the alley, too. And sometimes we get so caught up with things that we forget about life itself and instead of caring for our life and using it for others; we drop it, like the flowers, accidentally.

As "Gentle Evangelizers" perhaps we can reclaim the flowers. We could pick them up and nurse them back to life and beauty, and (+) brighten up someone's life with a cheerful visit. Or we could press the flowers and then (+) give our gift to someone in need. Or perhaps, we could be like a little child who (+) took them with a smile to his mother who did not even notice they were wilted, but only saw that they were a special gift to be treasured. (+) Seen any abandoned bouquets lately?

Father's Day Prayer

God our Father,
you govern and protect your people and shepherd them with a father's love. You place a father in a family as a sign of your love, care, and constant protection. May fathers everywhere be faithful to the example shown in the Scriptures: steadfast in love, forgiving transgressions, sustaining the family, caring for those in need. Give your wisdom to fathers that they may encourage and guide their children. Keep them healthy so they may support a family. Guide every father with the Spirit of your love that they may grow in holiness and draw their family ever closer to you.


