## Health & Safety of our Children

Spring is here, children are playing outdoors more often, and the weather is heating up. According to the Mayo Clinic, children under the age of 4 are more susceptible to heat exhaustion because of the body's lessened ability to regulate core temperature.

Symptoms of heat exhaustion include pale clammy skin, nausea, dizziness, fainting. More serious heatstroke symptoms include disorientation, fainting, body temperature of 104° or higher. If you see signs of heat exhaustion, move the child to a cool shaded area, losing clothing and dampen skin with a cool cloth, offer sips of cool (not ice-cold) water or sports drinks. If the child has fainted or is disoriented (signs of heatstroke), seek immediate emergency help."

As we enter into Spring, I'd like to take the opportunity to thank the Kolbe's Korner teachers and staff who have been so wonderful. They care for our children and truly nurture their academic and social growth throughout the year. We will be honoring them during Teacher Appreciation Week.
