## Donations for the Cloran-Borch Family - collecting donations thru tomorrow Friday, September 22nd

As some of you may already know, Carolyn Cloran, Ross Borch, and their boys Matt and Steve, were directly affected by the Hurricane Harvey flooding in Texas. They just left St. Mike's this summer to relocate to Texas and had only been in their house a month when Hurricane Harvey hit. They were able to make it to safety, but their house suffered heavy damage from over two feet of flooding inside. Their loss is estimated at about \$100,000, as nearly half of their home and belongings will need to be replaced. The repairs will take months, and they will be living in a rental.

To show our love and support for their family, St. Michael Parish School is collecting Costco Cash Cards (AKA Costco gift cards). They will be able to use these cards either in-store or on-line to purchase food, new furniture, new appliances, or even some of the remodeling work that needs to be done on their home. If you would like to donate a Costco Cash Card to their family, you can turn it in to the school's front office by Friday, September 22.
