As a student response device, this greater accessibility to iPads will allow our teachers to enhance their ability to assess learning using the depth of features in our truly ground-breaking Promethean panels. After seeing the amazing capabilities of our new Promethean panels following our training last week, it is clear that a second iPad cart will enhance our abilities to engage all learners using this technology.

Our morning Pre K aide, Heather Line, resigned this week to accept a full-time aide position at another school. We will certainly miss Miss Heather and are grateful for her contributions to the Pre K program. We are currently seeking applicants for this position.

Donations for the Cloran-Borch Family

As some of you may already know, Carolyn Cloran, Ross Borch, and their boys Matt and

Steve, were directly affected by Hurricane
Harvey flooding in Texas. They just left St.
Mike's this summer to relocate to Texas and had
only been in their house a month when
Hurricane Harvey hit. They were able to make it
to safety, but their house suffered heavy damage
from over two feet of flooding inside. Their loss is
estimated at about \$100,000, as nearly half of
their home and belongings will need to be
replaced. The repairs will take months, and they
will be living in a rental.

To show our love and support for their family, St. Michael Parish School is collecting Costco Cash Cards (AKA Costco gift cards). They will be able to use these cards either in-store or on-line to purchase food, new furniture, new appliances, or even some of the remodeling work that needs to be done on their home. 
