Timeline:

Food Collection – November 1st to the morning of November 17th.
School families can pick up baskets for delivery on November 17th after school.

Deliver baskets on November 18th or November 19th.

Each class has been assigned an item to fill the baskets.

Canned Veggies – Pre-K
Packaged Beans/Potatoes/Rice – Kindergarten
Cake/Brownie – 1st Grade
Pie Ingredients – 2nd Grade
Gravy Mix – 3rd Grade
Canned Veggies – 4th Grade
Canned Fruit – 5th Grade
Stuffing Mix – 6th Grade
Cranberry Sauce – 7th Grade
Stuffing Mix – 8th Grade

Each classroom will have baskets outside their door for donations. We are also seeking frozen turkey donations via a \$20 donation. The kids will be outside the office before and after school to take donations, and of course they can come directly to the office. We will have a bulletin board up to acknowledge those making a turkey donation.
