The most important reason Christians should be baptized is that the Lord Jesus commanded that all believers should be baptized (Matthew 28:18-20). Furthermore, those who are baptized are following the example Jesus set when He submitted to baptism by John the

Baptist (Matthew 3:13-17; Mark 1:9-11; Luke 3:21-22).

The Free Will Baptist Church states in its Articles of Faith the following about Christian Baptism . . . "We believe that this is the immersion of believers in water, in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit in which are represented the burial and resurrection of Christ, the death of Christians to the world, the washing of their souls from the pollution of sin, their rising to newness of life, their commitment to serve God, and their resurrection at the last day."

Although there are different ways to "baptize" Free Will Baptist practice baptism by "immersion." That means that we walk down into the water and are fully plunged under the water. Every part of the ceremony of baptism is full of symbolism. Walking into the water symbolizes our beginning to walk with Jesus. Being immersed symbolizes your death and burial with Christ. You have died to your sins. Rising from the water shows our hope of eternal life in Christ. Just as surely as He arose from His grave so shall we be raised from ours.

Any of our Pastors will be happy to talk with you and answer any questions you might have about baptism. If you have not experienced this "living parable" it would be a pleasure to arrange that for you. Please call the Church Office or speak to one of our Pastors if you have interest in baptism or simply want to ask questions.


