HURRICANE FLORENCE: OUR DISASTER PLAN

What a difference a week makes, especially when that week includes the arrival of Hurricane Florence! In the aftermath of the hurricane many of you dealt with property damage and the uninvited intrusion of water, everywhere. Our church was no different and unfortunately did not escape the damaging effects of rain and flooding. The basement saw the worst damage with water standing inches deep for several days. Before the clean-up company could begin their work, the entire basement had to be emptied, including furniture and carpet. Fans and humidifiers eliminated much of the water. With the help of many church members and friends, all the equipment, supplies, furniture, and personal belongings of the staff and administration were moved into the first floor hallways and fellowship hall. What followed at the beginning of this week was an emergency decision to relocate the office space to several first floor Sunday school classrooms while internal and external water damage and repairs are completed. While the timeline for utilizing the classroom spaces for offices is undetermined at this time, I am confident that all involved will exercise patience and understanding until all find their own place for meeting.
