Joel Menzel was 19 years old when God called him Home to heaven, but what a legacy he left!

Joel began college at Embry Riddle Aeronautical University in Arizona with a full AFROTC scholarship to pursue his other passion of flying and designing planes. In the spring of his freshman year, Joel strongly felt God's call to go into ministry. He then entered Concordia University Texas to pursue music ministry and pre-seminary studies. 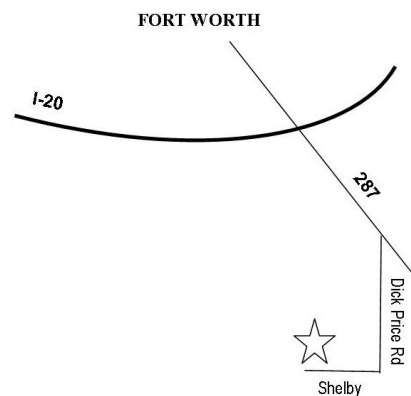
