Try having a "car devotion" sometime this week. Let us know how that goes next week.

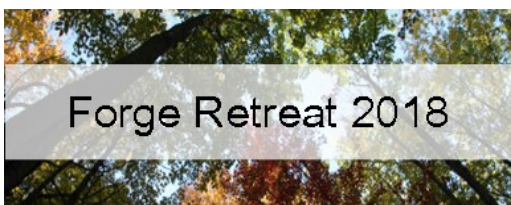
