According to verse 22 where does righteousness come from? How to sinners gain this righteousness?


Verse 25 talks about God's justice. If God is just, what should happen to sinners? How does Christ fulfill God's justice? (see Romans 5: 6-8)

One of the important things Luther did for the church was to translate the Bible into German. Before then, the Bible was only available in Latin—a language only spoken by very educated scholars and priests/monks. Just as Luther was finishing his translation, the printing press was invented. This meant that for the first time in history, people could not only read the Bible in their own language but also be able to afford to have their own copy!

Choose a verse from the bible. Use the letter stamps to create your own copy of the written Word of God just like Luther (and Gutenberg, the inventor of the printing press).

Why did you choose the verse you chose? Does it have meaning for you?

What do you think it would have been like to read the Bible for the very first time?
