We also want to take this time to look to the future and to make plans for how we will continue to proclaim the good news of Jesus and to live lives shaped by his love. What will St. Paul's look like in 50 years? The only thing we know for sure is that St. Paul's will look different than it does today.

St. Paul's began as an immigrant church and today we have first and second generation immigrants from Africa, South America, Asia, Europe, Central America and the Caribbean.

We must set ourselves to the work of building a future for St. Paul's by continuing the same effort of those who brought us to where we are today. We also must be ready for the Spirit to move in its own way and watch to see God do a new thing.


