Women's Book Group... We'd love to have new voices and thoughts in our Women's Book Group. During this year we have read fiction, non-fiction, historical fiction, mystery and classics. Our upcoming book discussion will be on April 28 at 2 p.m. in the Preschool Teacher's Lounge. The title of this book is "Mao's Last Dancer" by Li CunXin, a Chinese dancer who defected to the U.S.A. in April of 1981. This book is more than a glimpse into life in a Communist China in the early years; it is a glimpse into the personal life of a young boy "drafted" into a dance academy and all that it entailed.

Habitat For Humanity... We continue our fund-raising for the Habitat affiliate in Orange County for their work in Nicaragua. To date, we have raised \$7,083. Because that was so easy, we're going for \$10,000 which represents the cost of two basic houses in Nicaragua. We'd like to present a check for that amount on Pentecost.
