Pentecost is coming!...The “birthday of the Church”, the Feast of Pentecost, is Sunday, May 19.

This feast remembers the day that the Holy Spirit descended on the disciples gathered in Jerusalem, and they were empowered to preach the Good News to the world gathered there from all over.

It is a joyful custom of the church for everyone to wear RED on this day, the color we use to signify the Holy Spirit. Our worship at the 9:30 service on Sunday will be formal, joyful, and full of fabulous music.

Also, on the Eve of Pentecost at the 5:00 p.m. service, (May 18) the service will be held on the church patio, and followed by a potluck meal. Everyone is invited!
