FEED LUCAS COUNTY CHILDREN/SCHOOL SUPPLIES PROJECT

Feed Lucas County Children (FLCC) is a Christian summer activity program for low income children in the Toledo area. This program, based in many locations around the city, provides a safe environment, activities, and lunch for many children who wouldn't have this opportunity. The Outreach Board and St. Paul's members provide school supplies for some of the children who attend the entire eight week summer session. We collect the supplies and then donate them to FLCC. The collection will begin today, Sunday, July 15th and the deadline for school supplies will be on Sunday, August 5th. **How can you help?**

- 1. Choose a Ziplock bag from one of three age groups from the table in the Gathering Space/narthex. (grades 1-3, or grades 4-5, or grades 6-8)
- 2. Shop for the school supplies from a grade level list that is included with the Ziplock bag.
