Children & Youth

Birth-Age 2 children will hear Bible stories that are designed for young learners. Room 18

Ages 2-Pre K are studying "The Church". Room 4

Ages K-2nd grade and 3rd - 5th grade are using the Growing with Grace and Gratitude curriculum, which is rooted in the foundation of Presbyterian identity where God's grace and our gratitude are the heartbeat of our faith, life, and worship; which extends an invitation to discipleship that inspires children to learn and practice hospitality, generosity, and love; and which reaches beyond Sunday morning, encouraging children to live their lives as an expression of God's grace.

Ages K-2nd grade begin in Room 10 and move to Room 7. 3rd-5th grade begin in Room 10 and move to Room 8.

Ir. High and Sr. High will be using Feasting of the Word, which provides opportunities for this age group to explore their personal and communal identity in Iesus Christ through meaningful community building experiences, engaging Bible study, and relevant learning activities. Biblical stories will come alive in new and creative ways. In response to God's amazing, unconditional love, youth will be challenged to put their faith into action as they grow to understand themselves as Christ's disciples.

The Joy Class is for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities. We combine instruction, music and crafts to teach adults the basics of the Christian faith. This class uses shared leadership and is studying compassion. Parlor

In March the Alpha Class will be working their way through books of the Bible. Room A

<u>In March the Feasting on the Word Class</u> will be studying the following topics: March 5, will hear God's commands and identify what these commands mean for their lives. Genesis 2:15-17, 3:1-7; March 12, will explore God's covenant with Abram and discern the meaning of God's blessing in their lives as individuals and as the church. Genesis 12:1-4a; March 19, will examine how God leads Moses to respond to the people's cry for water and wrestle with what it means to trust and follow God. Exodus 17:1-7; March 26, In Samuel's anointing of David, adults will consider God's choice of an unexpected leader and commit to supporting God's leaders today. Room 11
