










Sign-up sheets for both will be located in the Oak Terrace every Sunday in November.

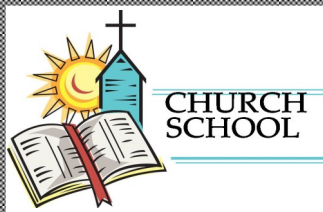


Poinsettia Sign-Up

Children & Youth

Birth-Age 2 children will hear Bible stories that are designed for young learners.

Ages 2-Pre K are studying "Abraham and Sarah". **Room 4**

Ages K-2nd grade and 3rd - 5th grade are using the Growing with Grace and Gratitude curriculum, which is rooted in the foundation of Presbyterian identity where God's grace and our gratitude are the heartbeat of our faith, life, and worship; and which extends an invitation to discipleship that inspires children to learn and practice hospitality, generosity, and love; and which reaches beyond Sunday morning, encouraging children to live their lives as an expression of God's grace.

Ages K-2nd grade begin in Room 10 and move to Room 7.

3rd-5th grade begin in Room 10 and move to Room 8.

Jr. High (6th-8th)- Will be using Echo the Story, which is a 12-week Bible overview for youth using storytelling, creative reflection, and dialogue. **Loft**

Sr. High (9th-12th)- Will be using Feasting on the Word, which provides opportunities for this age group to explore their personal and communal identity in Jesus Christ through meaningful community building experiences, engaging Bible study, and relevant learning activities. Biblical stories will come alive in new and creative ways. In response to God's amazing, unconditional love, youth will be challenged to put their faith into action as they grow to understand themselves as Christ's disciples. **Youth Hall**

Adults

Joy Class is for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities.

We combine instruction, music and crafts to teach adults the basics of the Christian faith. This class uses shared leadership and is studying compassion. **Parlor**

In November **Alpha Class** will be studying 2 Corinthians. **Library**

In November **Feasting on the Word Class** will be studying the following topics:
November 5th, 2017, will explore Jesus' criticism of the religious leaders and evaluate their own lives of discipleship. (Matthew 23:1-12)

November 12th, 2017, will name actions they can do now as they wait for God's unexpected arrival. (Matthew 25:1-13)

November 19th, 2017, will identify the "least of these" around them and consider ways to minister with them. (Matthew 25:14-30)

November 26th, will reflect on Christian community as a space to live together in a spirit of thanksgiving. (Matthew 25:31-46)

The Pastors are Visiting St. Philip Members

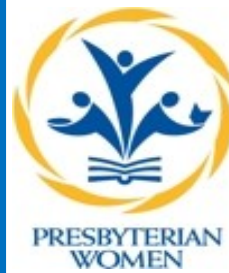
