Psalm 103:1-12 <sup>1</sup>Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.<sup>2</sup>Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:<sup>3</sup>Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;<sup>4</sup>Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with loving kindness and tender mercies;<sup>5</sup>Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.<sup>6</sup>The LORD executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed.<sup>7</sup>He made known his ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel.<sup>8</sup>The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy.<sup>9</sup>He will not always chide: neither will he keep his anger forever.<sup>10</sup>He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities.<sup>11</sup>For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him.<sup>12</sup>As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us.
