The Texas Civil War Museum will host a Civil War Living History on the front lawn June 14, 2008 from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM. The 9th Texas Infantry will demonstrate military drills, firing demonstrations plus other aspects of military life. Visitors will be able to visit with the soldiers. There will be no admission to the outdoor infantry camp.

Admission fee to the museum includes the award winning movie "Our Homes Our Rights - Texas in the Civil War" as well entry to all galleries exhibiting original artifacts from the Confederate and Union armies, original battle flags, Texas artifacts, as well as Victorian Era dresses. The museum is located at 760 Jim Wright Freeway North on the east service road between Clifford and Silver Creek (W. Loop 820 N). Admission to the museum galleries is \$6.00 adults, children 7 - 12 \$3.00. Operating hours are 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM Tues.-Sat.
