White Settlement—The Texas Civil War Museum will celebrate Old Settlers Day on October 24 with special programs throughout the day.

Among special attractions will be living historians dressed as Civil War soldiers, a Civil War Chaplin and demonstrations about period toys are among the offerings.

The museum has recently added several new items to its exhibits. These include uniform coats, and an 1859 ball gown.

The museum's operating hours are Tuesday through Saturday, 9 a.m. until 5 p.m. Admission prices are \$6 for adults and \$3 for student's ages 7-12. Children 6 years and younger free when accompanied by an adult. Group and active military discounts are available.
