Summer Camp 2017

This summer our focus will be on helping children to connect to the natural world and fostering stewardship of our planet.

Week One: A Rocky Start

Become a geologist and learn about the rock life cycle, gems, volcanoes, and how the Grand Canyon was formed. Play our *Panning for Gold game* and in our rock quarry; and create story stones for storytelling around our campfire. Mr. Ray will open the week with songs about our wonderful world.

Our Field Trip to the *Sterling Hill Mine* introduces children to rocks quarried in the Northeast. Each child receives a sample of six different rocks and learns how to identify them and their uses. The trip is open to school-age children.

All of the children will participate in a *Rocky Art Show*, creating beautiful art outside using natural items.

Week Two: Fabulous Fossils

Calling all dinosaur lovers! Learn about creatures and plants from the past and why some have become extinct. Create your own fossils; dig for fossils in our sandpit; and learn how you can help save plants and animals from extinction.

Our Field Trip to the *Morris Museum's Dinosaur Den* will allow children age 3 years and up to explore dinosaur footprints; listen to the sounds they made; examine fossilized teeth and eggs and learn about the lives of dinosaurs at the *hands-on interactive stations*.

An in-school Field Trip about gems and minerals presented by *Dinosaur Rocks*, will include an activity where the children *dig*, *find*, *and keep their own gems and minerals*. This program is for children age 3 years and up.

Week Three: Sailing, Sailing Over the Ocean Blue

Get wet while we learn about oceans; coral reefs; whales, dolphins; and penguins. Become a pirate and hunt for treasure at the end of the week!

Our Field Trip to the *Liberty Science Center* will allow school-age children to see what's swimming in the Hudson River.

The *Mad Science* people, *who transform laboratory science into fun, interactive learning experiences*, will present an in-house program to the 3- and 4-year old children called *Water Works*. Children will learn about the properties of water including floating, sinking and absorption, plus much more.

Week Four: Sports Camp

The camp is open to 4-year old children through school age.

Our Field Trip to *Imagine That is* open to the 2- and 3-year old children.

Week Five: Vacation Bible School

Our theme for this year is Noah's Ark.

We will have a visit from a special guest this week—a penguin from *Jenkinson's Aquarium* in Point Pleasant!

Week Six: Nature Lover's Week

Do you love being outside--looking and listening for birds and animals? Then, this is the week for you.

Our Field Trip to *Duke Farms* will teach the children about animal habitats, which they will see firsthand. This trip is open to 3-year old children through school age.

We will explore the habitat around our school and observe the animals we see there. The children will build birdhouses to take home so they can observe the birds in their own backyards.

Our in-school Field Trip is a *Mad Science* program, brought to you by the people *who* transform laboratory science into a fun, interactive learning experience. The children will learn about the incredible, diverse life in the animal kingdom and create their own casts of animal tracks. This program is available to school-age children.

Week Seven: Anything Goes

Join us for fun and prizes this week as we host our own *Amazing Race* and wacky water games. Try to choose the right box in *Let's Make a Deal* and see if you can complete a *Minute to Win It* challenge.

Our in-school Field Trip is *Challenge Island*, combining science, technology, engineering, art, and math, to create a fabulous and exciting learning experience for the children. This program is available to four-year-old children through school age.

Week Eight: Do You Want to Be in Show Business?

We'll end the week with a play about being stewards of the earth. The children will help build and paint scenery; learn about lighting; create programs to print and hand out; and put on a big production that will receive rave reviews!

Our in-house program will be Stretch the Silly Man.
