Featured Missionary— Elisabeth Elliott

The life of Elisabeth Elliot was one marked by tragedy but also deep joy and contentment. She met her future husband, Jim Elliot, while attending college. They married and became missionaries to Ecuador. After only three years of marriage, Jim, along with four other missionaries, were tragically killed when they attempted to make contact with the Aucas, a tribe in the area. While many people would be turned towards resentment and depression after such a tragedy, Elisabeth took comfort in the sovereignty of her God. Several years later, Elisabeth took her and Jim's young daughter and went to live with and minister to the very same people group who were the cause of her husband's death. Many in the tribe came to know Christ because of Jim's death and Elisabeth's faithfulness. Elisabeth would go on to write many books, all of which are marked by a contentment that can only be explained by true joy in Christ. Elisabeth knew that in Christ came ultimate satisfaction and this truth marked a life of consistent obedience.
