



Dear LHOP Friends

I want to open this letter by sending our best greetings and hoping that both you and your family are doing well. This time I want to write a little bit about situations of those who participate in our program and tell you more about the youth camp we organized with group from Midland, TX.

We have currently done some investments in our program. We regularly support Kacper by paying for his English lessons, we can see a great progress. He is a part of our worship team and plays the drums. We paid for his music lessons previously and now we can see the fruit of it.



Sandra is currently in a boarding school 25 km away from our town. We support her education, she does very well and she sings in our worship team.

Natalia is doing well, she recently had a birthday. It is good to see that she is doing well; we continue to support this family



Simon has just completed 5 weeks of rehabilitation in a hospital where they tried to restore his mobility as well as straighten body posture and eliminate stature defects. This is just a beginning of this road, he requires many years of rehabilitation to improve his condition. We support his rehabilitation.

Dominika is a girl who during the youth camp experienced incredible change. She became open and courageous, and that is a great improvement. She is in high school and we support her education.

Ignacy also does well, he is with his parents and we support his education and help by covering part of the costs of going for Christian youth camp during the summer.

Simon will probably receive government funding to buy specialist wheelchair. He can receive 50% of the value, so we are waiting to add our 50%. At this point we are all waiting for the government funds to come.



Marcel, due to his condition, is still very aggressive and his family has to constantly focus on him. We have just purchased new rehabilitation equipment for him, something that will interest him and catch his attention. Marcel still doesn't talk, only his parents can understand his gestures, but we are sure that new equipment will improve his autistic life.

Krystian is the one for whom we bought professional treadmill. It helps him to be fit, and to improve his health as he is also autistic child. He has recently gained weight, so trying to stay in shape is another challenge for his parents.



Jacob was able to have a great dose of private rehabilitation at his home. This is the most effective way to help him. We have been doing this for years now.

Justyna gets our help in form of doctor visits due to her epilepsy. We bought school supplies for her.

Jacob – his life got more complicated because last year at the age of 45 his father died due to diabetes and other complications. Jacob is with his mother and his legs still require rehabilitation and he can barely walk.

Konrad is a miracle child and every month of his life is a miracle. No one expected that he is going to live that long. We pay for his rehabilitation which certainly prolongs his life.

Maja is still in a foster family. Her mother, despite a yearlong therapy and abstinence, got back to drinking a few times which resulted in hospital detox. So her future is still not certain.

Natasha- her situation also didn't change. She is in foster family and her life got a lot better.

Generally speaking in our CSP program we closely observe the situation of our children. React when circumstances change and listen carefully to the parents and families as they know best where the biggest problems and challenges are.



We have already booked Christian camps for 7 teenagers and 9 children. So we will help to finance 16 children, which is challenging, but we always have faith that God will supply the needs.



And finally few words about the winter youth camp that we had a privilege to organize. We were there for a few days with a group of 50 young people and experienced something incredible with God. God is faithful and allowed us to renew and refresh our relationship with Him. His presence was there, young people experienced breakthroughs, healings and many special moments. God moved in an incredible way, and we were able to see many changed hearts, and there was absolutely no one who left without being changed. To God be the glory for this young generation of people who experience Him in such a great way.
