October 3 Morning ANGELS

"Are they not all ministering spirits sent forth to minister for those who will inherit salvation?" (Hebrews 1:14)

Angels are the unseen attendants of the saints of the strong one (God/Elohim). "For He shall give His angels charge over you, To keep you in all your ways. In their hands they shall bear you up, Lest you dash your foot against a stone" (Psalm 91:11—12). The chosen are elevated to high dignity when the angels of heaven become our willing servants. We are well defended, since all the twenty-thousand chariots of the strong one (God/Elohim) are armed for our deliverance (Psalm 68:17 "The chariots of the strong one (God/Elohim) are twenty thousand, even thousands of thousands; the master (Lord/Adonai) is among them as in Sinai, in the Holy Place").

Let *the Master (Lord/Adonai)* Jesus Christ be forever endeared to us, for through Him we "are raised up and made to sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus" (Ephesians 2:6 "and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus").
