FLAMINGO FLOCKING







For the second year in a row Danville has been invaded by a fun-loving flock of flamingos who volunteered their time to help raise money to support the joint youth program of The Presbyterian Church, Trinity Episcopal and - for the first year - First Christian Church. As before, the community came through and the fundraiser was a grand success. 88 locations were flocked, with 8 getting flocked more than once. 2030 flamingos were placed around Boyle County. Donations given in support is already topping \$3,000! These funds will go toward supporting the combined youth program in our continued ministry of outreach, education, shared experiences and faith formation.

SESSION REPORT

The Session held its regular monthly meeting on September 12, 2017. Two members of Transylvania Presbytery's Pastoral Transition Commission (PTC), Rev. Darryl Baker and Rev. Jim Gilbert, were present. Rev. Baker served as Moderator for the meeting. Rev. Gilbert left after the exit interview. This is a summary of the reports received and actions taken at that meeting.

EXIT INTERVIEW

Rev. Baker and Rev. Gilbert asked the Session members for their assessment of the current condition of the church and stressed the need to maintain regular worship and congregational life during the transition and search for a new pastor.

CORRESPONDENCE

Two letters have been received from Hope Springs along with checks for \$1000. One is for the Soups on Us ministry, and the other is for unrestricted use by the church.

A letter has been received from Jerry Utt, Stated Clerk of the Transylvania Presbytery, stating that Rev. Hannah McIntyre has been named Moderator of the church Session.

OLD BUSINESS

Session approval for the baptism of Marcus Bolton Strauch at the 11:00 service on September 3, 2017, with Rev. Hannah McIntyre officiating, was completed by email on August 18.

COMMITTEE REPORTS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

Budget and Finance (Tom Quilligan and Bill Garriott)

The August and September financial reports were reviewed. The committee continues to be concerned about the decline in non-pledged giving compared with last year, but at this point we remain close to our budget plan in both revenue and expenditures. Congregational giving is about 3% less than the budget plan through August, and current expenditures are also about 3% less than budgeted.

Acting on a recommendation from the committee, the Session approved a motion to add year-to-date giving to the Session Report included in each month's *Salt Shaker*. As of August 31:

Year-to-date budgeted giving: \$304,364 Year-to-date actual giving: \$294,912

Adult Formation (A. J. Strauch)

All four adult classes have gotten off to a good start.

WHIRLwind will include adult programming after the meal.

Children's Formation (Laurie Pierce)

Godly Play started with good attendance, and included Adult Godly Play for the first time.

WHIRLwind programming for children will include Bible study, choir and crafts.

Youth Formation (Hannah McIntyre)

Hub Devotions began on Wednesday, September 6.

PYC met for the first time on September 10.

Membership (Charlie Boyd)

New member orientation will be on Sunday, November 5, and the new class will be received on Sunday, November 12.

Stewardship (Bill Garriott and Mark Tibbles)

At the suggestion of the committee, the Session agreed to support the inclusion of a target budget in the 2018 stewardship campaign.

Worship and Music (Mark Hoebelheinrich and Rita Bloom)

On the recommendation of the committee, the following ministers were approved for the month of October:
