The quality of the relationship equals the weight of the influence.

When our kids are smaller, we have a <u>SIZE AND POSITION</u> advantage.

I'm bigger than you and I'm dad (or mom).

- leading from size and position as kids

Our goal is to <u>TRANSITION</u> from leading by size and position to one of influence.

I've got stuff you don't have that you think you need.

- leading from size and position as teenagers

Leading from size and position when you kids are teenagers $\underline{\sf ERODES}$ the relationship.

- Let's face it, you will always win using size and position.

Relationship Barriers

- 1. Using ANGER as discipline
- 2. Focusing on <u>PROBLEM-SOLVING</u> instead of empathy.
- 3. <u>LECTURING</u>
- 4. <u>CRITICIZING</u>

Listening to your teen

F – Focus – give your undivided attention

- A Accept
- D Draw out ask questions.

Where are you?

Level 1 – <u>GREETING</u> Level 2 – <u>FACTS</u> Level 3 – <u>OPINIONS & JUDGEMENTS</u> Level 4 – <u>EMOTIONS</u>

Level 5 – <u>SPIRITUAL CLOSENESS</u>

Rules without relationship leads to rebellion.

It's not about behavior modification. It's about character development.

What level are you on?

Eleven ways to connect with your teenager:

- 1. Talking
- 2. Listening
- 3. Touching hug, hand on the shoulder
- 4. High-energy Activities play a game together
- 5. Interests What does your teenager like?
- 6. Special Treats Ice cream, candy bar, etc.
- 7. Partnering Serve somewhere together
- 8. Praise Admire something and communicate it.
- 9. Fun Spontaneous laughter = healthy relationship
- 10. New times in a teen's life
- 11. Traumatic Events
